Thank you very much for your recent donation of \$300 on 03/26/20. The funds will be used to help cover the shelter's operating expenses at the NKY Convention Center. On March 12 ESNKY made the difficult decision to close the winter shelter early due to inadequate space for required social distancing and began working with other agencies to provide shelter at the Northern Kentucky Convention Center. The Convention Center shelter closed in early April, and almost 40 adults who were at highest risk were relocated to a local hotel. ESNKY and our partner agency, Welcome House, continue to provide meals, case management and supervision for these individuals.

We are grateful for the support of our donors and community partners whose financial and in-kind assistance make our life-saving work possible.
