

Return to Worship: What to Expect

- Face masks and physical distancing will be required.
- Health checks and sign in will happen prior to entering the building.
 - Health check includes taking your temperature and answering this question: “In the past 14 days have you been within 6ft or less for more than a few minutes with anyone who is suspected of having Covid-19 or who has had Covid-19?”
- Entrance to the church building will be through the accessible lobby only (may add front entrance if usher/greeters are available)
- One-way traffic will be routed through the first floor of the church building and around the sanctuary. (refer to map, follow signs)
- Hymnals and Bibles will not be available in the pews at this time.
- Listening devices will be assigned to regular attendees, so that you will always use the same one – put in bag with your name.
- An electronic version of the worship bulletin will be available on the website and the Saturday e-Weekly Reminder. A few paper versions will be available if you forget to print yours.
- Communion may be celebrated with individually packaged wafer/juice.
- The offering plate will not be passed at this time. Instead, it will be placed on a table near the accessible entrance and in the center aisle near the front doors.
- The nursery will not be open at this time.
- Only the accessible restroom will be open. There will be cleaning wipes and spray available to sanitize after yourself.
- Exit from the building can be through the Fairfield Avenue door, the non-accessible door to the parking lot, and the accessible lobby, while still following the one-way traffic flow.
